The new facility, which opened to the public in August 2014, has been expanded to include high-quality exhibitions and hands-on interactives. The TDC illustrates the fundamental role transportation played in shaping the history and growth of Moncton and highlights the City of Moncton's position as the transportation hub of Atlantic Canada.

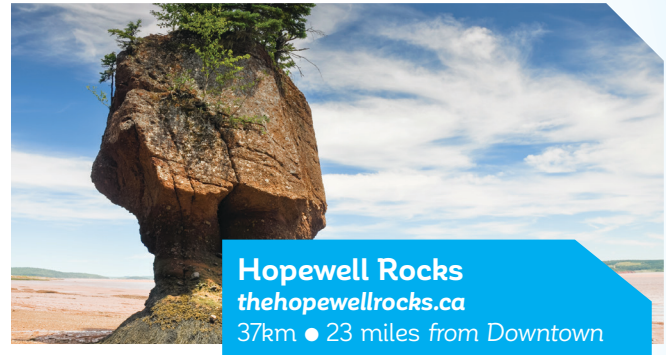
### Olivier Soapery

### Hopewell Rocks

### Cape Enrage

At Cape Enrage (Frommer's has named this site one of the most scenic views in Canada); just a few miles from Hopewell Rocks on your way to Fundy National Park, the scene is so breathtaking, you'll find it hard to describe the emotions it evokes. Here you'll find the oldest lighthouse on mainland New Brunswick. For the more adventuresome, there's zip-lining and rappelling. Restaurant on site.
